



Campsite Conditions

Campers, visitors & security All visitors must report to the Shop if arriving between 9am-5pm Mon to Sat or 9.30am-12.30pm on Sunday. If you arrive outside these hours, please ring Colin on 07970 663975. Pitch fees payable on day of arrival. Any additional guests, ie people that have not paid to stay, must report to the Farm Shop before entering the Site.

Pets are welcomed but must be kept on a lead. No fouling on site and accidents cleaned immediately. Please ask about local dog walks. Maximum of 2 dogs per unit. Well-behaved dogs are allowed in seating area of the Farm Shop.

Driving Speed limit 5mph from entrance. Uninsured, banned & learner drivers are not allowed to drive on premises.

Waste & rubbish Wipes, nappies, sanitary products etc. must not be flushed down the toilets. Please wrap and place in the bins provided. Elsan point to be used for chemical toilet waste, grey water in wooden shed. Please use waste bins provided for their identified purpose. We do not remove unwanted camping equipment. Please do not drop litter.

Water Please use the designated water outlet to clean chemical toilets and do not use the fresh water hose.

Children under 8 years-old must be accompanied when using the washroom/utility facilities. Be aware of where your children are and what they are doing. Do not enter private areas. When using the front play paddock, children must be supervised at all times. Please vacate the play area by 7pm.

Ball games are not allowed on the actual campsite. Ask at reception if there is a designated area and consider others.

Noise Please consider others and keep noise from television, music, animals, children etc. to a minimum. Quiet time 11pm-7am. No vehicle movements after 11pm unless in an emergency, if using a taxi, please ask them to drop you off at the front of the buildings.

Groundsheets Depending on ground conditions or length of stay, you may be asked to lift your groundsheet to preserve the grass. Breathable groundsheets are expected to be used.

Barbecues/fire pits Please take care not to burn grass. Blocks are available by the waste bins to be used and replaced to protect the ground.

Smoking No smoking in buildings. Please use galvanised buckets at edges of the campsite to extinguish cigarettes.

Hook ups are 16 amp. Wi-Fi is an automatic connection - complete the registration and create your own password.

Horses Please do not feed the horses or enter the fields with horses - all fencing is electric and you will get shocked.

Wet Conditions If conditions are very wet please ask for assistance and we will be more than happy to tow you out if required.

The owners of the site are absolved of all liability for accidents to caravans, tents, motor homes, guests and from responsibility for loss or damage to personal property. The owners reserve the right to ask any persons not observing these conditions, or creating a nuisance to leave the site.
